Review of the Trade in Endangered Species Act 1989: Release of Discussion Document

Portfolio Conservation

On 28 August 2019, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV):

- noted that the Trade in Endangered Species Act 1989 (TIES Act) has a category 5 priority on the 2019 Legislation Programme (drafting instructions to be issued to the Parliamentary Counsel Office in 2019);
- **noted** that the Minister of Conservation intends to release a public discussion document to support the review of the TIES Act;
- noted that the discussion document will cover the following policy areas:
 - 3.1 the trade in elephant ivory;
 - 3.2 movement of taonga across international borders;
 - 3.3 personal and household effects;
 - 3.4 technical issues with permits;
 - 3.5 cost recovery;
- 4 **agreed** to the release of the discussion document, attached to the paper under DEV-19-SUB-0232, subject to any minor, editorial or design changes that may be required prior to its release;
- 5 **invited** the Minister of Conservation to report back to DEV with recommended amendments to the TIES Act following the public consultation.
