### Ruapehu Volcanic Risk Management

**DOC Risk Management Stage A. VAL 1:**  
700m Public advised not to enter area.

**DOC Risk Management Stage B. VAL 1 (increased unrest but no VAL change):**  
1.5km Public advised not to enter area and concession activities suspended.

**DOC Risk Management Stage C. VAL 2:**

2km Area closed and concession activities suspended.

3km Regular meetings held to consider 2 km to 3 km closure extension and intensified lahar path risk management per the criteria and process from the guidelines for DOC volcanic risk management in Tongariro National Park.

**High Risk Lahar Paths:** Public advised not to enter these areas and concession activities suspended.

**VAL 3 to 5:**

4km Area closed and concession activities suspended. Lahar path risk management intensified per the guidelines for DOC volcanic risk management in Tongariro National Park.

**Ruapehu Lahar Hazard**  
Indicative 1 in 100 year lahar paths shown. Lahar impacts are highly variable and unlikely to be as widespread as shown.
