



Warning: Make sure you're well prepared as alpine weather changes quickly. Check in at the Tongariro National Park Visitor Centre before heading out into the alpine environment.

### Te Iringa

This site is at the start of the Te Iringa Track, which is popular for hunting, tramping and biking.



Access: Gravel road. Note: No water, bring your own water supply.

### Clements Clearing

This large campsite is a good place to base yourself to explore the Kaimanawa Forest Park.

Directions: 27 km east of Taupo, turn right off SH5 into Taharua Rd and follow for 9.5 km, then turn right into Clements Mill Rd and follow for 9 km.

Access: Gravel road.

I.ATITUDE: -38.94744 LONGITUDE: 176.18449

### Kakapo

This campsite is near tall forest, scrubland and tussock grasses.

Directions: 27 km east of Taupo, turn right off SH5 into Taharua Rd and follow for 9.5 km, then turn right into Clements Mill Rd and follow for 10 km. Access: Gravel road.

### **Army Road**

Camp in an area of diverse terrain; activities include hunting, hiking, fishing and rafting.

Directions: 27 km east of Taupō, turn right off SH5 into Taharua Rd and follow for 9.5 km, then turn right into Clements Mill Rd and follow for 12.5 km.

Access: Gravel road. LATITUDE: -38.96796

LONGITUDE: 176.15483

### **Clements Road End**

This site is at the start of the Hinemaiaia Track.

Directions: 27 km east of Taupo, turn right off SH5 into Taharua Rd and follow for 9.5 km, then turn right into Clements Mill Rd and follow 21 km to road end.

Access: Gravel road.

I.ATITUDE: -38.98849 LONGITUDE: 176.14278

Camp in a large sunny clearing above the river. A shelter with a fireplace is available.

Directions: 15km south of Turangi on SH1, turn left onto Kaimanawa Rd. After 3.5 km turn left, then left again over the bridge.

LATITUDE: -39.13750 LONGITUDE: 175.83050





### Kaimanawa Road

This is a rustic campsite set high above the road.

Directions: 15 km south of Turangi on SH1, turn off onto Kaimanawa Rd. After 3.5 km turn right up the hill and take the first left. Access: Gravel road.

Note: No water, bring your own water supply.

### Urchin 8

This is a quiet and remote campsite. Mountain bike the Tree Trunk Gorge or the Pillars of Hercules to Desert Road tracks.

Directions: 15 km south of Turangi on SH1, turn off on to Kaimanawa Rd, after 3.5 km turn right and follow signs. Access: Gravel road. Note: Water is from 150 m down the Tree Trunk Gorge Track.

LATITUDE: -39.15418 LONGITUDE: 175.82306











### Pokaka Mill

This is a basic campsite in the Tongariro Forest Conservation Area.

Directions: Off SH47 at the end of Pukehinau Rd. Access: Rough gravel road, 4WD recommended. Note: No water, bring your own water supply.

LATITUDE: -39.04398 LONGITUDE: 175.50998

### 10 Mangahuia

This is a peaceful campsite beside the Mangahuia Stream on the edge of Tongariro National Park.

### Whakapapa Holiday Park

Camp in a large sunny clearing above the river.

Directions: Drive south on SH48, past Chateau Tongariro. Look for the sign on the right, just past the Visitor Centre. Access: Sealed. Booking: Required. Book online at www.whakapapa.net.nz or phone (07) 892 3897 from 8 am to 6 pm.

### Mangawhero

Camp in the forest on the flanks of Mt Ruapehu; a good base for exploring the park.

Directions: Ohakune Mountain Rd, 2 km from Ohakune. Access: Some gravel. Booking: Required.

### Whakaipo Bay

Camp next to Lake Taupo and enjoy the farm park surroundings and the mountain bike track through native bush.

Directions: Drive 10 km from Taupō through Acacia Bay and take Mapara road. Turn off into Whakaipo Bay at the DOC signpost. Access: Drive down a well-maintained pumice road to the camping area.

Note: Overnight stays only in self-contained vehicles. No camping in tents or other vehicles.
