

Marlborough Sounds road access: Due to serious slips following a major storm in August 2022, there is no access or limited road access to some DOC campsites in the Marlborough Sounds. Check the district council website at www.marlborough.govt.nz for the latest information.

1 Moawhitu



Moawhitu campsite is accessible only by boat or by air (landing fee applies).

Stunning, remote campsite adjacent to a surf beach with good fishing, hunting, tramping and mountain biking nearby.

Directions: In Greville Harbour/Wharariki, Rangitoto ki te Tonga/D'Urville Island. **Access:** Boat only, or barge from French Pass to Kapowai then a 27-km 4WD drive to Moawhitu. Airstrip (landing fee applies) for small private aircraft; 20-min walk from airstrip to campsite. **Note:** Moawhitu is exposed to high winds and rough seas – take care on the water. Dog permit required, dogs on lead at all times; ph (03) 520 3002.



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South Arm

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LATITUDE: -40.80562

Dramatic, remote, sheltered campsite at the head of South Arm. Great base for boating and hunting.

LONGITUDE: 173.81549

Directions: At Port Hardy, Rangitoto ki te Tonga/ D'Urville Island. **Access:** Boat only.

3 Mill Arm

Picturesque, remote campsite near the head of Mill Arm with well-formed flat sites and views.

Directions: Greville Harbour/Wharariki, Rangitoto ki te Tonga/D'Urville Island. **Access:** Boat only. **Note:** Stream is prone to flooding, so take care in high rainfall.

4 Penguin Bay

Small campsite with a picturesque stream and stunning views to the mainland. Catherine Cove Resort is nearby.

Directions: On the east coast of Rangitoto ki te Tonga/D'Urville Island. **Access:** Boat only.

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5 Lucky Bay

Small, scenic campsite with great views, popular with sea kayakers and boaties.

Directions: On the east coast of Rangitoto ki te Tonga/D'Urville Island. Access: Boat only.

Road access to French Pass may be restricted. See the alert on page 10.

Gateway to Rangitoto ki te Tonga/D'Urville Island; watch the waters moving through Te Aumiti/French Pass, go fishing and boating, or just relax.

Directions: Turn off SH6 north of Rai Vallev into Ronga Road which becomes Croiselles-French Pass Road and follow 60 km to the end.

Access: Sealed and gravel, narrow winding road; or boat access. Booking: Required.

Waiona Bay


In striking surroundings, campground mainly used by kayakers. Hunting, boating and walking.

Directions: At Apuau Reach, Pelorus Sound/ Te Hoiere, Access: Boat only.

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

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19 Picnic Bay



Road access to Picnic Bay is closed. Access by boat only.

This is a scenic area with walking, sea kayaking, motor boating, fishing and birdwatching.

Directions: Turn off Queen Charlotte Drive at Linkwater into Kenepuru Road and follow 2 km past Portage. **Access:** Narrow, winding road or by boat. **Note:** Dog permit required, dogs on lead at all times; ph (03) 520 3002.



Access by boat only.

This flat campsite is in a sheltered bay and offers a good base for exploring by sea or by land.

Directions: Turn off Queen Charlotte Drive into Kenepuru Road and follow 3 km past Portage. **Access:** Narrow, winding road or by boat. **Note:** Dog permit required, dogs on lead at all times; ph (03) 520 3002.

21 Kumutoto Bay

A sheltered east-facing bay with a short walk, boating, water skiing and fishing close by.

Directions: In the inner Queen Charlotte Sound/ Totaranui. **Access:** Boat only. STANDARD

22 Ratimera Bay


A popular site with a long sandy beach for fishing, boating and picnicking.

Directions: Ratimera Bay, Queen Charlotte Sound/ Totaranui. **Access:** Boat only.

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


Road access to Waimaru is closed. Access by boat only.

Isolated campsite in a rural area, ideal for those wanting a remote experience.

Directions: Turn off Queen Charlotte Drive at Linkwater into Kenepuru Road, after 42 km turn left to stay on Kenepuru Road, turn into Manaroa Road, then follow Clova Bay Road to the end. Note: Restrictions on Kenepuru Road. Check www.marlborough.govt.nz before your trip. Access: Gravel, narrow and winding road.

Campsite for boaters and sea kayakers in a peaceful setting.

Directions: Kauauroa Bay, Tawhitinui Reach, outer Pelorus Sound/Te Hoiere. Access: Boat only.

A remote campsite with hunting and water-based activities near by.

Directions: Outer Queen Charlotte Sound/Totaranui. **Access:** Boat only.

BACKCOUNTRY

30 Davies Bay

Large accessible site with boating activities close by. Choose from a waterfront site or a bush clearing.

Directions: A 3 km walk or mountain bike from Anakiwa. **Access:** Mountain bike or walk from the Queen Charlotte Track or by boat.

31 Aussie Bay



Road access to Aussie Bay is under repair – take care. See the alert on page 10.

A popular waterfront campsite with great views and vehicle access.

Directions: Off Queen Charlotte Drive in the Grove Arm of Queen Charlotte Sound, 15 km from Picton. **Access:** Steep driveway with tight turn, no vehicles over 6 m. Access also via the Link Pathway.

Note: Dog permit required, dogs on a lead at all times; ph (03) 520 3002.

Grove Arm of Queen Charlotte Sound, 13 km from Picton or 17 km from Havelock along Queen Charlotte Drive. **Booking:** Required.

North-facing site; great for water-based activities in the outer Queen Charlotte Sound/Tōtaranui.

Directions: Northern side of Arapawa Island. **Access:** Boat only.

BACKCOUNTRY

37 Rarangi

Camp next to the beach and enjoy the sound of the surf at this dog-friendly campsite.

Directions: 8 km north of Blenheim turn off SH1 at Tuamarina into Hunter Road, left into Pembers Road/ Rarangi Road, and follow left into Rarangi Beach Road until you reach the campsite. Access: Sealed. Note: Dog permit required, dogs on a lead at all times; contact renwick@doc.govt.nz.

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Whites Bay 38

This camp has lovely scenery and is situated at a safe swimming beach.

Directions: 8 km north of Blenheim turn off SH1 at Tuamarina into Hunter Road, left into Pembers Road/ Rarangi Road, and follow left into Rarangi Beach Road. Take sharp left into Port Underwood Road and follow to Whites Bay campsite. Access: Sealed, narrow winding road.

39 **Robin Hood Bay**



The road to Robin Hood Bay is under repair - take care. See the alert on page 10.

Camp next to the beach, with a surf beach nearby and watch for Hector's dolphins.

Directions: 8 km north of Blenheim turn off SH1 at Tuamarina into Hunter Road, left into Pembers Road/ Rarangi Road, and follow left into Rarangi Beach Road. Take sharp left into Port Underwood Road and follow to Robin Hood Bay.

Access: Winding and gravel road from Whites Bay. Note: Dog permit required, dogs on a lead at all times; contact renwick@doc.govt.nz.

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The road to Onamalutu is under repair take care. See the alert on page 10.

This campsite is set in remnant podocarp forest and has a safe swimming hole.

Directions: Turn off SH6 west of Blenheim into Northbank Road for approx 6 km. Turn right into Onamalutu Road and follow for 7 km to the camp. Access: Sealed.

Mill Flat 41

This isolated campsite, accessible by 4WD only, is in a grassy clearing surrounded by beech forest.

Directions: No road access via Northbank Road. Foot access via Pine Valley Road only. Access: Last 2 km 4WD only, river crossing required. Note: Dog permit required, dogs on a lead at all times; contact renwick@doc.govt.nz.

42 Marfells Beach

Camp next to the sea and enjoy the stunning wildlife and scenery.

Directions: From SH1 follow Marfells Beach Road to the end. South side of Lake Grassmere/Kapara Te Hau. Booking: Required. Access: Sealed, some gravel.





Kowhai Point

Camp next to the Wairau River, with fishing and swimming nearby.

Directions: Adjacent to SH63, Wash Bridge, Wairau River. **Access:** Sealed.

44 Puhi Puhi

This peaceful grassy campsite is near a short scenic native bushwalk.

Directions: Off SH1, 9 km north of Kaikōura, turn inland up Puhi Puhi Road, after Hāpuku River bridge. Camp is 6 km along the road. **Access:** Gravel road.

The following two campsites are on the Acheron Road which runs through Molesworth. Access conditions apply.

Access: Gravel road. Not suitable for vehicles with trailers, caravans or buses. **Note:** Acheron Road is open from Labour Weekend to Easter or the second Saturday in April, whichever is later. Weather conditions and fire danger can close it at any time. Check online at www.doc.govt.nz/molesworth for current road status.

45 Cob Cottage

Camp near the original Cob Cottage built in 1885, close to the Molesworth Station boundary.

Directions: 3 km north of Seddon turn off SH1 into Awatere Valley Road and drive 100 km (approx 2 hr 30 min) to campsite. **Note:** Vehicles over 7 m long are not permitted on Acheron Road.

LONGITUDE: 173.2702



Camp by this historic cob building from 1863, once used as an overnight drovers' stop.

Directions: Take the Clarence Valley Road from Hanmer Springs (via Jacks Pass Road), continue right into Tophouse Road and follow the Acheron Road 17 km to campsite. (Or drive 59 km south of Cob Cottage along the Acheron Road.) Acheron Road is open 7 am – 7 pm between October and April. **Note:** Vehicles over 7 m long are not permitted on Acheron road.



47 Lake Tennyson Scenic Reserve

This isolated campsite beside Lake Tennyson offers trout fishing, kayaking, boating and walking opportunities.

Directions: From the north, turn off SH63. Follow Wairau-Hanmer Springs Hydro Rd (aka Rainbow Rd). Turn-off to campsite is signposted on right. From Hanmer, drive over Jacks Pass. At the bottom of Jacks Pass turn left into the Clarence Valley/ Rainbow Road. Drive 32km up this road. Lake Tennyson is signposted to the left. Access: Rainbow Road is 4WD only and is a toll road with seasonal access. For access, contact Rainbow Station: email info@rainbowstation.co.nz or visit www.rainbowstation.co.nz. Alternatively, 2WD from Hanmer Springs all year – gravel road.





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
